

State School Placement

inlingua Cheltenham has established a close relationship with six local state schools who are willing to take well educated students from overseas onto their normal courses for students aged 14- 18 years.

The schools offer a full curriculum for students who have the language level to cope with year 10, 11, 12 or 13. Year 10 is the first year of GCSE preparation and year 11 is the year of GCSE examinations. Year 12 is the first year of A Levels known as AS levels and year 13 is the final examinations known as A2 examinations. If a student wishes to attend any of the examination years (11, 12 and 13) then inlingua Cheltenham will approach the school to see if this would be possible.

During years 10 and 11 student normally study up to 11 subjects
During years 12 and 13 students normally study 3 or 4 subjects

The student will need to be at a language level of at least intermediate level in order to be successful in the school curriculum. Therefore it may be advisable to attend a preliminary English for Academic Purposes course with us at inlingua Cheltenham in the Summer months prior to the start of the school year in September.

All state schools in the UK work on the basis of a three term year, starting in September. All accommodation issues will be dealt with by inlingua Cheltenham during the whole period of stay.

The Cotswold School

The Cotswold School is situated in Bourton-on-the-Water, a village located approximately 15 miles from Cheltenham. The school gained Specialist Language College status in September 2002, followed by Specialist Science Status in 2007.

There are currently 800 students in the main school (11 - 16 years) and 300 in the Sixth Form (17 and 18 years).

Chipping Campden School

A specialist Technology and Language school which is located in Chipping Campden in the north of the Cotswolds, 22 miles from Cheltenham and 11 miles from Stratford-Upon-Avon. Chipping Campden School has been a Specialist Technology School since 2000 and became a Specialist Languages College in 2006. In 2009 the school became a Technology, Language College and Leading Edge Partnership School

The school currently has 1080 students aged from 11 - 18 years.

Farmor's School is a mixed school for 11-18 year olds situated in beautiful parklands near the centre of Fairford, approximately 24 miles from Cheltenham. In 2004 Farmor's School became a Business and Enterprise Specialist School. In June 2007 the school was designated as a High Performing Specialist school which led to a second specialism in Science being taken on.



There are currently 1050 students studying at Farmor's School, with 200 of these in the Sixth Form
